Training classes from the Workers' Compensation Division

Claim processing issues

Forms, time lines; whom to contact for help; dispute-resolution processes; and employer, worker, insurer, and doctor responsibilities

Employer coverage

Insurance contract, independent contractor specifics, extraterritorial reciprocity, subject workers, subject employers, Small Business Ombudsman for Workers' Compensation, guaranty contracts, and non-compliance sanctions

Injured-worker benefits

Time-loss payments, medical treatment, worker-requested medical examinations, vocational retraining, return-to-work help, appeal rights, and dispute resolution

Medical issues

Medical-fee disputes, billing issues, medical-fee schedule, CPT codes, HIPAA, medical marijuana, medical-treatment disputes, insurer medical examinations, and serving as a medical arbiter

Return-to-work assistance

Employer-at-Injury Program, Preferred Worker Program, vocational retraining, worksite modification, light-duty requirements, wage subsidy, premium exemptions, and Job Match Program
