



The Workers' Compensation Division's Modernization Program has been focused on our Workers' Compensation Information System (WCIS) project. We recently expanded the project which decreased the implementation timeline and overall cost. Since the summer of 2023, the Modernization team has been hard at work with the assistance of an IT professional service vendor to review and document current processes and design future state process models. The WCIS project also includes enabling system access for our external stakeholders. Currently, the WCIS Project's Request for Proposal (RFP) is in the final stages of external review. When approved, the RFP will be posted on OregonBuys for potential solution vendors to respond to. When reviewing these proposals, the RFP evaluation committee will be looking for technology solutions that will support the business needs of the division and enable and enhance accessibility and communication options for our stakeholders. We expect to have a solution vendor selected and system implementation beginning in early-mid 2026.
