My preliminary thoughts:

The data from our articles was that the interoperative PRP didn't provide better results (may be counterproductive as well). The articles reviewed indicated that PRP works best for situations where there is chronic inflammation, or acute mechanical tissue disruption (but trauma below the level of disruption requiring surgery). Using PRP as an interoperative or immediately perioperative adjunct to a surgical procedure does not have support in the peer-reviewed medical literature as far as I am aware.
