Medical Advisory Committee

The Medical Advisory Committee, Workers' Compensation Division, is reviewing the surgical procedure lumbar disc arthroplasty, using scientific studies and other information. The goal of the committee is to determine whether the surgical procedure is unscientific, experimental, unproven, or outmoded. The committee will be guided in its consideration by Oregon Revised Statute 656.245(3), Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 436-010-0300, and committee-developed criteria. If the committee determines that the surgical procedure is not unscientific, experimental, outmoded, or unproven, the committee may establish parameters of appropriateness for the procedure's use.
